## **ANNUAL REPORT**

**HYDERABAD CLEFT SOCIETY (HCS) AND GSR INSTITUTE OF CRANIOFACIAL AND FACIAL PLASTIC (GSRICFS) FOR 2012**

2012 has been a year that the HCS and GSRICFS has consolidated its position as a premier Institute of Craniofacial Surgery in India.

### **Statistics**

The Cleft Children International (CCI) funded for **1785** cleft surgeries that included, primary cleft lip and palate surgeries and secondary cleft surgeries like rhinoplasties, orthognathic surgeries and alveolar bone grafting surgeries. Of the 1785 cleft surgeries done, we performed **921** primary cleft lip and palate surgeries. The CCI also funded **29** intra cranial craniofacial surgeries for the year 2012.

We have also done **4** trauma surgeries, **12** distractions, **44** tumor resections, **8** orthognathic surgeries, **4** TMJ surgeries, **48** craniofacial surgeries and **32** esthetic rhinoplasties with funds raised locally and internationally.

We have done **1729** speech assessments and **1227** speech therapies during the same period. We have started **20** orthodontic treatments during this time which have been funded by the CCI.


We have started construction of a new hall of residence that will accommodate 60 school children. The new building will be completed by the end of April 2013 so that the students can begin the new academic year here.

### **ARC Academy**

We are now funding 14 young maxillofacial surgeons from around India to do cleft surgery. In 2012 these young surgeons performed more than 200 cleft surgeries.

### **Future Projects**

The GSRICFS plans to establish the Medicine 2.0 project for cleft lip and palate population in Andhra Pradesh, India in 2013. The Medicine 2.0 project is about realizing the potential of today's technology in health care. Its applications, services, and tools are Web-based services for health care consumers, caregivers, patients, health professionals, and biomedical researchers, that use virtual-reality tools, to enable and facilitate a better health system. This system emphasizes collaboration, participation, and openness, as opposed to the traditional, hierarchical, closed structures within healthcare and medicine.
